**WHEREAS**, the Kenosha County Board adopted the “*Comprehensive Bike Plan for Kenosha County 2025*” in 2013 which established a strategy and plan for developing a network of safe, bike and pedestrian friendly, interconnected trails throughout Kenosha County’s City, Towns and Villages, and

**WHEREAS**, in recognition of the health, quality of life, economic, environmental and traffic congestion mitigation benefits that alternate transportation infrastructure offers, several State and Federal agencies provide funding opportunities through defined grant programs that financially assist in the design and construction of these types of infrastructure improvement projects, and

**WHEREAS**, consistent with and to further implementation of the *Plan*, the Kenosha County Highway Division is proposing an off-street multi-use trail on the south side of County Trunk Highway (CTH) C within the existing right-of-way, between 128<sup>th</sup> Avenue and CTH U in the Village of Bristol as illustrated on the attached map, and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed trail will extend an existing trail along CTH C further west, connecting the City of Kenosha, Village of Pleasant Prairie and Village of Bristol and appears to be eligible for Federal “Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP)” funding, and

**WHEREAS**, the design and construction of the proposed .5-mile trail is estimated to cost \$937K of which, TAP funding would cover \$750K (80%), leaving a net Kenosha County contribution of \$187K (20%), and

**WHEREAS**, for the Kenosha County Highway Division to initiate a TAP funding grant request, a resolution of support, authorizing application is required from the Kenosha County Board,

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the County Board of Supervisors supports and authorizes the Kenosha County Highway Division to apply for a TAP grant for this project.
