



WHEREAS, Kenosha County created a comprehensive restoration plan for the Pike River consisting of three major phases within Petrifying Springs Park, and

WHEREAS, the restoration project will improve water quality, habitat and ecological functioning of the Pike River, control erosion, and increase pedestrian accessibility in this urban green infrastructure hub, and

WHEREAS, Phase I and Phase II of this project was completed in 2019 and 2021 respectively, and

WHEREAS, Phase III of this project proposes 3,067 linear feet of streambank and ecological restoration initiatives including inclusive improvements to pedestrian safety and accessibility within Petrifying Springs Park, and

WHEREAS, WDNR Targeting Runoff Management (TRM) grant funding is available to partially fund the construction of the Pike River Phase III River and Habitat Restoration project in Petrifying Springs Park; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of the of the Pike River Phase III project is \$3,100,000, of which the TRM grant would support \$225,000 to support the project funding; and

WHEREAS, if Kenosha County receives the grant, the source of the County match will be included within the proposed 2024 County budget; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Kenosha County Board of Supervisors authorizes the Director of Parks to act on its behalf to submit an application to the WDNR for a TRM Grant, sign documents and take necessary action to undertake, direct and complete the submission of the grant application for these projects.
