



For the last 28 years, I have been licensed as a Social Worker through the State of Wisconsin Dept. of Safety & Professional Services. Recognizing the need to become knowledgeable of substance use disorders, I returned to school to become licensed as a Clinical Substance Abuse Counselor in 2012, In 2020, I became licensed as an Independent Clinical Supervisor.

Working with the offender population both in the correctional setting and in the community prepared me to work with individuals with substance abuse, mental health, and a history of criminal/delinquent behaviors. In addition to the offender population, I have had the opportunity to work with individuals suffering from substance abuse and mental health disorders in the community and hospital settings. As a Clinical Supervisor in a methadone clinic, I saw first hand how the opioid crisis has plagued the community. Now as a Lead Licensed Behavioral Health Counselor/Clinical Supervisor, I see how substance abuse and mental health disorders affects individuals and the need for individuals to have access to treatment.

Being knowledgeable of the resources available in the community and how individuals can access these resources is experience that I can bring to this Commission. In both my professional and volunteer work, I have always had a desire and passion to help others.
