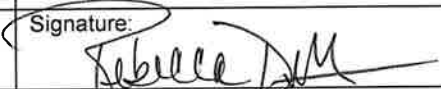

WHEREAS, Our nation has an Opioid crisis. Kenosha County had 53 toxicity deaths in 2021 and 2022 numbers are anticipated to be higher, and

WHEREAS, prevention and education are key in fighting this crisis, starting with our youth, and

WHEREAS, Substance use education in our schools is limited, and evidence based curriculum programs are available, and

WHEREAS, Kenosha County received Opioid Settlement funding money through the nationwide lawsuits for opioid abatement, and

WHEREAS, the Opioid Settlement funding list of opioid remediation uses includes funding for prevention programming, and

WHEREAS, the Kenosha County Opioid Settlement Panel has recommended the creation of a position to focus on substance use prevention and education in our schools, and

WHEREAS, the position of Community Prevention and Education Specialist's role will include partnering with the school systems to implement and monitor a substance use prevention and education program that works with resources like the DARE program and school resource officers to expand education in Kenosha County schools, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Kenosha County Division of Aging, Disability & Behavioral Health Services create a new position of Community Education and Education Specialist funded by Opioid Settlement funds, and

Therefore, the Kenosha County Board of Supervisors have approved a 1.0 FTE for the Community Prevention and Education Specialist.
