6. Presentation by Dan Bahr with Wisconsin Counties Association Legislative Update- Mr. Bahr gives an update on the childcare costs and subsidies: The Governor put a 300-million-dollar request in the budget this year.

State Public Defender Pay- \$70/hr. for private bar conflicts, County Ordered at \$100/hr. The State wants to raise it to \$100/hr. to keep in line with the County so that the private bar doesn't hold out for County rate. There is also an \$8.76 Raise for District Attorney's should help retention and hiring process.

County Conservation Staffing Grants-will fund 100% of 1st, fund 70% of 2nd, 50% of 3rd positions. Dah Bahr speaks on Wisconsin Land and Water.

He speaks on Shared Revenue: Currently the State gets 950 million dollars from the State, share that with the towns, cities and villages. Kenosha County currently receives \$1,398,000.00 in shared revenue and essentially there is \$260,000,000 more. Mr. Bahr speaks briefly on the Local Supplemental Transportation Program. Discussion ensues regarding electric and hybrid cars and taxing.
