Supervisor Nedweski

Reported an update that on a state level, a budget motion was made regarding the resolution from Human Services asking for an increase in child support funding.

Supervisor Stock

Reported that ongoing projects were discussed at the Public Works meeting on Monday. The Kemper Center utilization plan is underway. The Parkside multi use bike trail ribbon cutting was Friday June 2<sup>nd</sup>. Encouraged everyone to go check out the new trails. Construction at HWY A and HWY Y roundabout is underway, and completion should be Fall of 2023. The Old Settler's Park band shelter will open with a ribbon cutting on June 8<sup>th</sup>. Seasonal hiring is continuing for the facilities department. Next Public Works meeting will be Saturday June 26<sup>th</sup> at the Pringle Nature Center. Open house will be from 530-630 and will hopefully have a demo of the new accessible wheelchair. Human services renovation and relocation bid package part one was due May 19<sup>th</sup> and will be bidding on part two in June. The Human Services Committee met just prior to the County Board meeting and passed 4 resolutions which will be on the June 20<sup>th</sup> County Board Meeting agenda.

Supervisor Berg

Reported that the Racial Ethnic & Equity Commission met on May 18<sup>th</sup>. Brian Gonzalez was voted as Vice Chair and Commissioner Solis was voted in as Chair. Subcommittees were handed out and include law enforcement, health, and housing. All committees are full except Health if anyone in the community is interested in getting involved in the health subcommittee there is an opening for that.

Supervisor Grady

Had a question for Public Works on the update for road construction in Twin Lakes on the eastern side of Lake Elizabeth and Lake Mary. Per Supervisor Karow – still waiting on castings for manhole covers as the original company they were ordered through had a fire and they had to reorder them from another company. The whole road has been milled and they are 40-50 percent complete on grading for the new paving. The utility company is still working on relocating the gas line.
