Town of Salem – The Rebels and Redcoats will fight an epic battle this weekend to determine if Fox River Park will remain in Kenosha County or will become part of the British Empire.

The Rebels and Redcoats Revolutionary War Reenactment will be held on June 23rd and 24th at Fox River Park, 9521 30 Ave., Burlington. It is hosted by the North West Territory Alliance and sponsored by Community State Bank, Kenosha County Executive Jim Kreuser and the Kenosha County Division of Parks.
