Resolution from the Division of Emergency Management:

1) FY11 WI Office of Justice Assistance MABAS Base Station Radio Grant

Motion by: Singer **Seconded by:** Grulich **Approved:** unanimously

Chief Deputy Smith presented the resolution to accept \$17,000 from the State of Wisconsin Office of Justice Assistance for the purchase of a Mutual Aid Box Alarm Base Radio. The grant requires a 15% hard match that they already have. This is a replacement for the current system that is not capable to be narrow banded and will become obsolete at the end of 2012. Beginning 1/1/13, KSD must go to narrow banding as mandated by the Federal Government.

Resolutions from the Kenosha County Sheriff's Department:

1) Probationary Cabaret License – Remo's Corner

Capt. Apker presented the resolution. Business was formerly JT's Fieldhouse and Finney's West. The premises were found to be in conformity with the Cabaret Ordinance. He recommended approval. Entertainment planned is Country & Western bands and DJ's. Cameron and Debra Krehbiel from Remo's attended the meeting.

2) Activity Control License – Country Thunder East, LLC

abstaining; approved by all others

Apker reported that the festival will be run the same as last year; campground, performers, law enforcement, etc. A deposit of \$110,000 has already been received to cover law enforcement, Highway Department, and Health Department. In the past about \$10,000 has been refunded. Brent Wiederfeld, a representative from Country Thunder, attended the meeting.
