- ***Boundless Adventures: Kenosha County Parks and Boundless Adventures have been awarded the Wisconsin Park and Recreation Association, Silver Star Award for Creative Service Delivery/Marketing.***
- ***Petrifying Springs Park – Old Park Administration Building: Demolition plans underway for building to be burned by Somers Fire Department in spring, 2020. Lead and asbestos abatement completed, water lines will be re-routed in November.***
- ***Petrifying Springs Park Biergarten: Biergarten closed for the season on 10/19/19.***
- ***Kemper Center – Restroom Remodel Project: Bids were due on 10/24/19. No bidders on this project and will seek alternative methods to complete project.***
- ***Kemper Center – Door replacement project: Three exterior doors were replaced at Kemper Center as part of the 2019 CIP.***
- ***Park Operations: Pavilion rental season came to an end on 10/20/19. Operations are transitioning workforce to winter preparation, forestry operations, facility & grounds upgrades and equipment maintenance.***
