NOTICE TO ELECTORS: THIS BALLOT MAY BE INVALID UNLESS INITIALED BY 2 ELECTION INSPECTORS. If cast as an absentee ballot, the ballot must bear the initials of the municipal clerk or deputy clerk. IMPORTANT: Use a #2 pencil or the marking pen provided. DO NOT USE RED INK. To vote for the candidate of your choice, completely darken the oval to the LEFT of the candidate's name, or go to the write-in section at the end of the ballot that appears with the write-in instructions, and write the person's name on the appropriate office line provided.

### PARTY PREFERENCE

If you wish to designate your party preference, completely darken the oval to the LEFT of the party of your choice. If you designate a party preference, only votes cast for that party will be counted. If you do not designate a party preference and vote for candidates of more than one party, no votes will be counted. **YOU MUST VOTE FOR INDIVIDUAL CANDIDATES.**
