RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SCHOOL DISTRICT BUDGET TO EXCEED REVENUE LIMIT BY \$300,000 FOR NON-RECURRING PURPOSES

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of the Joint School District #1, Towns of Wheatland, Brighton, Randall and Salem, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, that the revenues included in the School District budget for the 2005-2006 school year and for three school years thereafter, to and including the 2008-2009 school year be authorized to exceed the revenue limit specified in Section 121.901, Wisconsin Statutes, by \$300,000 a year, for non-recurring purposes in order to maintain the current educational level of the District and cover shortfalls due to decreased funding.
