For Partisan Office

FOR CITY OF KENOSHA TOWNS OF BRIGHTON, BRISTOL, PARIS, RANDALL, SALEM, SOMERS AND WHEATLAND. VILLAGES OF PADDOCK LAKE, PLEASANT PRAIRIE, SILVER LAKE AND TWIN LAKES.

NOTICE TO ELECTORS: THIS BALLOT MAY BE INVALID UNLESS INITIALED BY 2 ELECTION INSPECTORS. If cast as an absentee ballot, the ballot must bear the initials of the municipal clerk or deputy clerk. **IMPORTANT:** Use a #2 pencil or the marking pen provided. **DO NOT USE RED INK.** To vote for the candidate of your choice, completely darken the oval to the LEFT of the candidate's name. To vote for a person whose name does not appear on the ballot, write the person's name on the line provided and darken the oval.

PARTY PREFERENCE

If you desire to vote a straight party ticket for all state, congressional, legislative and county offices, darken in the oval to the left of the party of your choice. A straight party vote cannot be cast for independent candidates. To vote for individual candidates of your choice, darken in the oval to the left of the name of the candidate. When voting for governor/lieutenant governor, you may vote only for the candidates on one ticket jointly or by writing in the names of persons on the lines provided and darkening the oval.

QUESTION NUMBER I**

Under State law, the increase in the levy of the Village of Pleasant Prairie for the tax to be imposed for the next fiscal year, 2007, is limited to 4.734%, which results in a levy \$7,317,972. Shall the Village of Pleasant Prairie be allowed to exceed this limit and increase the levy for the next fiscal year, 2007, by \$168,564 (or 2.41%) for the purpose of purchasing an ambulance, which results in a levy of \$7,486,536?
