If cast as an absentee ballot, the ballot must bear the initials of the municipal clerk or deputy clerk. **IMPORTANT:** Use a #2 pencil or the marking pen provided. **DO NOT USE RED INK.** To vote for the candidate of your choice, completely darken the oval to the LEFT of the candidate's name. To vote for a person whose name does not appear on the ballot, write the person's name on the line provided and darken the oval.
