- Prescription medications
- Over-the-counter-medications
- Ointments and creams
- Pet medications
- Sprays
- Liquids
- Inhalers

Cross out personal information or peel off the label from the package.

Place all medication in a sealed bag and place into the drop box.

NOT ACCEPTABLE

- Biohazardous materials
- Needles/sharps/syringes
- Illegal Drugs
