INITIAL RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING
GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS
IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED
\$52,500,000

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of the Kenosha School District No. 1, Kenosha County, Wisconsin (commonly known as the Kenosha Unified School District), that there shall be issued, pursuant to Chapter 67, Wisconsin Statutes, General Obligation Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$52,500,000 for the purpose of paying the cost of renovations to the Indian Trail Academy and constructing and equipping additions thereto in order to create a comprehensive high school facility with academies.

RESOLUTION TO EXCEED REVENUE CAP
BEGINNING WITH THE 2010- 11 SCHOOL YEAR
BY AN AMOUNT OF \$2,427,000

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of the Kenosha School District No. 1, Kenosha County, Wisconsin (commonly known as the Kenosha Unified School District), that the final school district budget beginning with the 2010-1 1 school year shall include, on a recurring basis, an amount of \$2,427,000 in excess of the revenue limits imposed by Section 121.91 (2m) of the Wisconsin Statutes for the purpose of paying operation and maintenance costs of a new comprehensive high school facility with academies.

Question II.

Shall the School Board of the Kenosha School District No. 1 (commonly known as the Kenosha Unified School District) be authorized to exceed the revenue limit under Section 12 1.9 1 (2m) of the Wisconsin Statutes beginning with the 2010- 11 school year on a recurring basis by an amount of \$2,427,000 for the purpose of paying operation and maintenance costs of a new comprehensive high school facility with academies as provided in the foregoing resolution?
