- **COVID-19 Updates:**
  - *Dog Parks – Reopened on 5/22/20*
  - *Playgrounds – Reopened on 5/22/20*
  - *Kemper Center and Anderson Arts Center – Durkee Mansion tentatively reopening 7/1/20. Anderson Arts Center anticipates reopening on 6/16/20.*
  - *Pringle Nature Center: Online courses & programs available. Facility closed until 7/31/20.*
  - *Petrifying Springs Biergarten – Opened for season on 5/22/20*
  - *Boundless Adventures – Opened for season on 5/22/20*
  - *Lakeland Little League – Anticipate opening on 6/1/20*
  - *Yoga & Fitness in the Park anticipated to start in June*
  - *Special Events including movie nights, concert series and runs/walks canceled through 7/31/20*
  - *Pavilion rentals canceled through 7/31/20.*
  - *Silver Lake Beach – opening in June with limited occupancy.*
  
- **Kemper Center**
  - *Storm Damage: County continues to virtually meet weekly with FEMA representatives on scoping restoration projects due to the January storm damage at Kemper Center.*
  
- **Kenosha County Veterans Memorial Park Restroom Facility:** *Contractor completed excavation and pouring of concrete foundation. Project on schedule to be completed by early August, 2020.*
