Public Works/Facilities Committee Parks Division Status Report for January 4, 2021

- **Kemper Center**
 - **Boiler & Chiller Replacement:** Boiler startup is scheduled for the first week of January 2021. Chiller installation is expected to be completed in January with final startup occurring when exterior temperature reaches 70+ degrees.
- **Kenosha County Veterans Memorial Park:**
 - **Debris & Site Restoration:** County Park staff actively working to complete final cleanup of miscellaneous debris (from the original property owner) from western section of park.
 - **Prairie Restoration:** Contractor scheduled to seed approximately 26 acres of prairie in early January. Prairie restoration was accomplished with the financial assistance of a US Fish and Wildlife Service grant.
- **Petrifying Springs Park Playground #4 Improvements:** The CTH “KR” bridge was transported to Petrifying Springs Park on 12/11/20 in preparation for the Area #4 pedestrian bridge replacement project in 2021.
- **Pringle Nature Center:** See attached reports.
- **South Bike Trail:** The first phase of the south bike trail stormwater management project will include selective brush clearing starting in early 2021. Brush removal will be self-performed by county park personnel based on the results from the stormwater management study, design review, and recommendations.
