



# COUNTY HIGHWAY S EAST FRONTAGE ROAD TO WIS 31

## Project Update

November 2, 2021



Kenosha County, in partnership with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT), has successfully reconstructed County Highway S from the Interstate 94 East Frontage Road to WIS 31. **The entire project area is now reopened to traffic.**

### The following work was completed in two phases:

- Reconstruction of 3.6 miles of County Highway S from a two-lane rural roadway into a four-lane divided highway with the addition of turn lanes
- Installation of an 8-foot-wide multi-use path for bicycle and pedestrian accommodations
- Replacement and installation of existing and new traffic signals along the corridor
- Improved drainage, including a Regional Stormwater Pond
- Bridge constructed over the Canadian Pacific Railway to accommodate the newly constructed westbound lanes
- Bridge constructed over the Kilbourn Ditch to accommodate the newly constructed westbound lanes
- Safety improvements included separating eastbound and westbound traffic, alignment improvements at side street intersections, and installation of guardrails
