## Public Works/Facilities Committee Parks Division Status Report for January, 2022

- ***Kemper Shoreline Revetment:*** Kenosha County will be applying to the FEMA Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC) grant for 75% financial match assistance to the Kemper Center shoreline revetment. Grants are due at the end of January.
- ***Petrifying Springs Park Pavilion #3 & #5:*** Repairs to Pets Pavilion #3 & #5 are set to occur over winter and early spring to mitigate structural issues that were identified as part of a conditional study conducted in 2021. Future foundation repairs will be needed for these shelters.
- ***Petrifying Springs Park & UW-Parkside Multiuse Trails:*** The first pedestrian bridge was installed in December. Design for the remaining four bridges are substantially complete with bids due on 2/17/22.
- ***Pike River Phase III:*** Request for Proposals for design and construction management services are due on 1/22/22. Design will take place during the 2022 construction season.
- ***Pringle Nature Center:*** See attached report.
- ***South Bike Trail:*** Brush and tree clearing to manage stormwater along the South Bike Trail has started again in December. Work will continue as conditions allow during the winter and early spring months.
- ***Special Project Coordinator:*** The full-time Special Projects Coordinator position is currently posted and will close on 1/21/22. The new position is open to internal and external candidates.
