COUNTY HIGHWAY U TO CLOSE

Kenosha County is underway with the reconstruction of the County Highway Q (104th Street) and County Highway U (136th Avenue) intersection, which began in early October 2021 with a scheduled completion of summer 2022. The following work is scheduled for the next phase of the project.

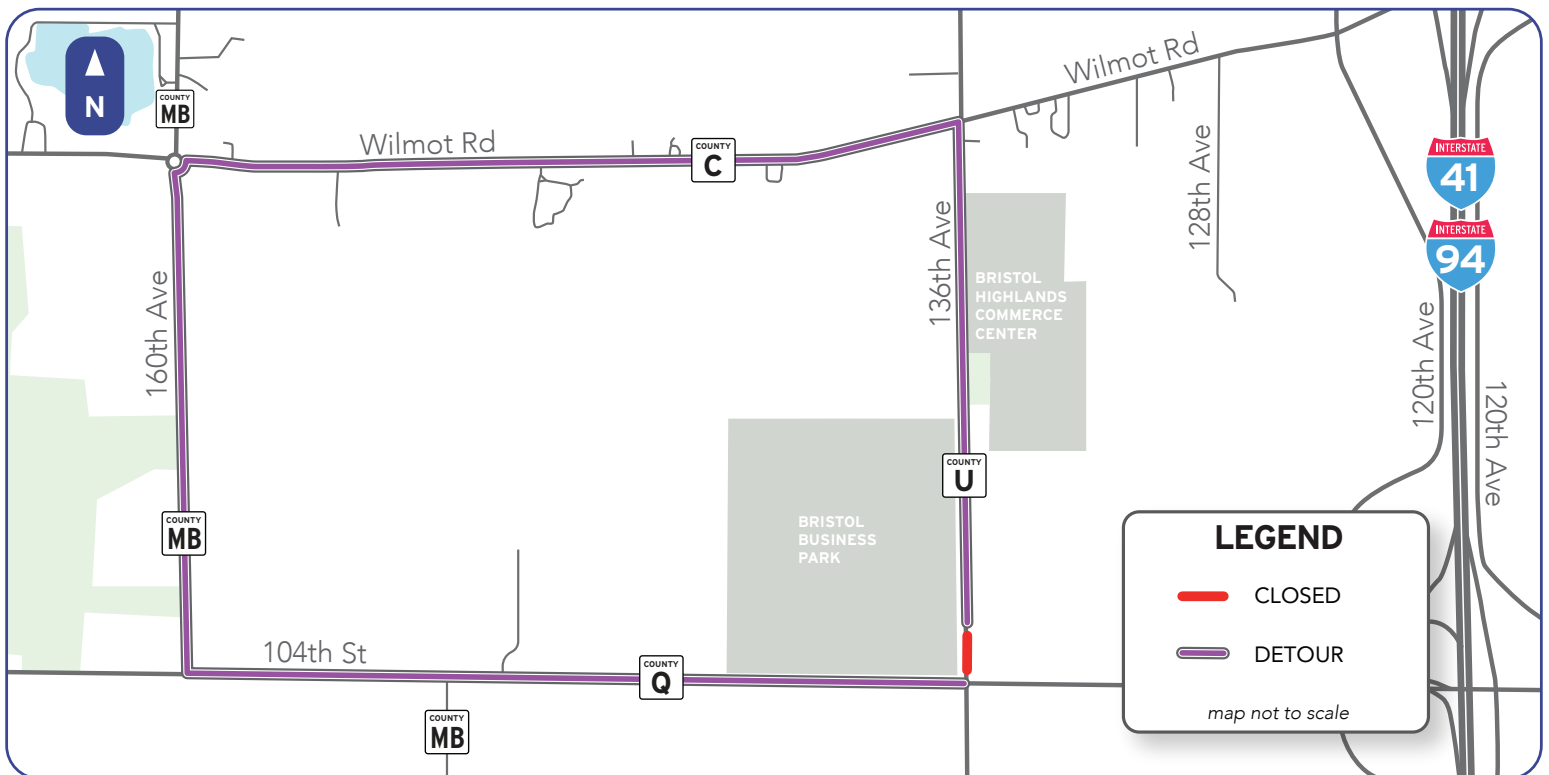
THURSDAY, MAY 5TH:

- County Highway U (136th Avenue), just north of County Highway Q (104th Street), is scheduled to close to traffic by 6 a.m. through mid-summer 2022, while crews work to reconstruct the intersection.
- Motorists should plan ahead and use an alternate route to avoid delays.

Access to businesses and residences will be maintained.

Detour Route:

- Motorists are encouraged to utilize County Highway Q (104th Street), County Highway MB (160th Avenue), County Highway C (Wilmot Road), and County Highway U (136th Avenue) to get around the closure.
