COUNTY HIGHWAY Q TRAFFIC SWITCH

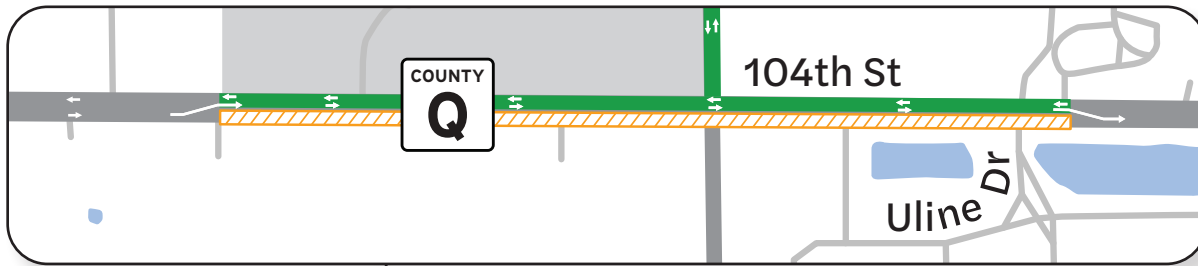
Kenosha County is underway with the reconstruction of the County Highway Q (104th Street) and County Highway U (136th Avenue) intersection which began in early October 2021 with a scheduled completion of late 2022. The following work is scheduled for the next phase of the project.

Thursday, October 6:

- Traffic on County Highway Q (104th Street), from just east of Uline Drive to just west of County Highway U (136th Avenue), is scheduled to be shifted to the north to the newly paved westbound lanes, while crews work to construct the eastbound lanes.
- County Highway U (136th Avenue), just north of County Highway Q (104th Street) is scheduled to reopen to traffic.

Access to businesses and residences will be maintained throughout construction.

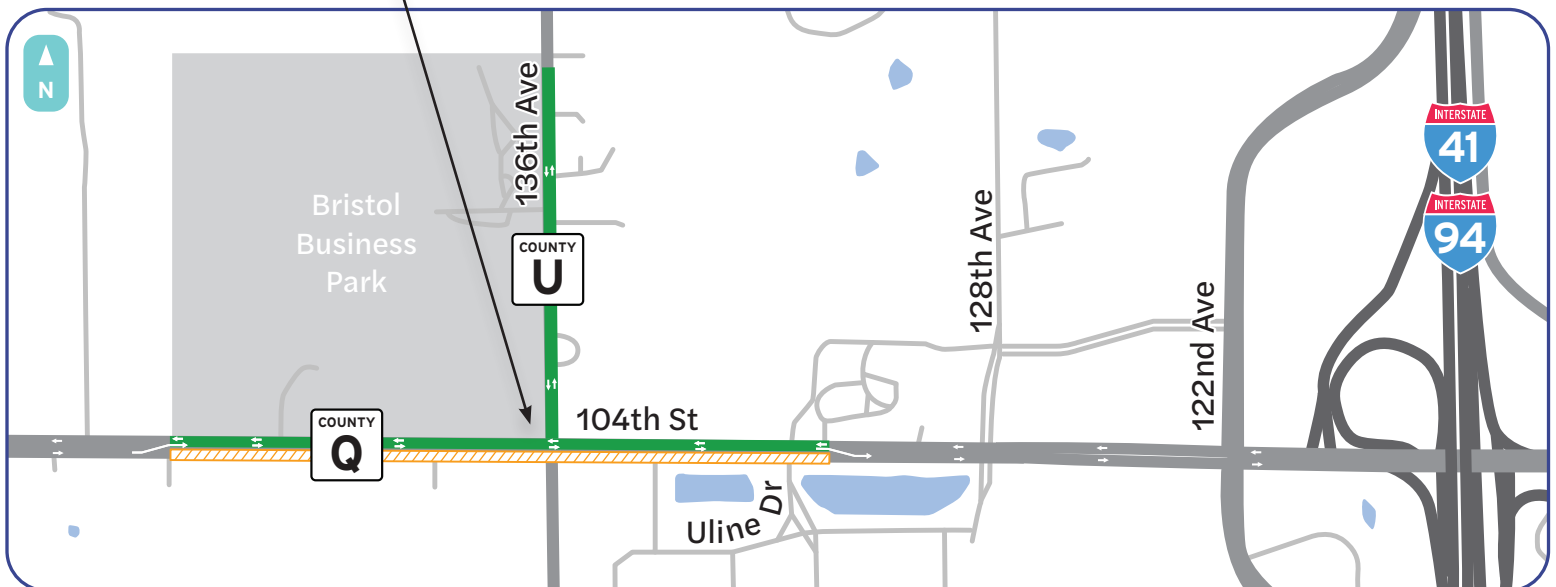
Please note that all work is weather dependent and subject to change.
