## PROJECT UPDATE

### Highway Y and Highway A Intersection

## WHEN and WHAT

**Project Construction Period:**  
March 2023 through  
August 2023

**What's new:** The intersection, which reopened to traffic in June, will be closed for one day on **Tuesday, August 15**, for the installation of permanent streetlight poles. A posted detour will be in place.

(Note: This closure is weather-dependent and is subject to change)

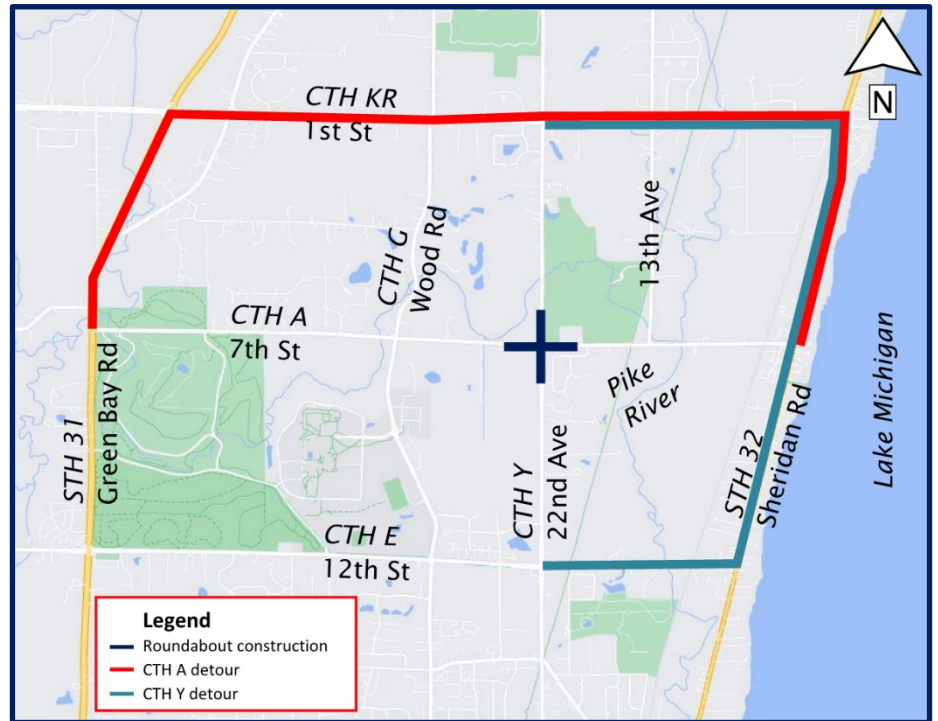
**What's next:** The project will be substantially complete with the installation of the permanent lighting.

## PROJECT INFORMATION

Kenosha County is currently reconstructing the intersection of Highway Y (22<sup>nd</sup> Avenue) and Highway A (Seventh Street) in the Village of Somers.

The intersection is being converted from a 4-way stop into a single-lane roundabout.

Work was largely completed in June, although temporary lighting has been in place pending the arrival of permanent equipment.
