

Respite and Adult Day Services

Caring for someone can be very tiring, and sometimes it's nice to have some help. This help is often called "Respite Care" and can offer a much-needed break, while others care for your loved one. The following information includes programs and facilities that provide care for your loved one, when you are not available. They provide oversight and supervision. It can be for just a short time, off and on for just when you need help, or a longer time. Care can also come to you at home if that's more convenient and less stressful.

Insurance doesn't usually pay for respite services, so most are paid for privately. Some funding may be available, so if you'd like to find out more about possible help paying for respite care, or if you'd just like to talk to someone about caregiving options that can come to the home, please call the Aging & Disability Resource Center at 262-605-6646 or 1-800-472-8008.

Options for care outside of the home

Provides daily leisure and recreation opportunities for adults over 18 years, with disabilities. Clients participate in a variety of weekly activities including swimming, exercise, gym time while socializing with peers. Program runs Monday-Friday, on a weekly half-day or full day basis. Offers activities for adults with disabilities. Offers recreational activities, healthy meals, snacks and extensive personal care services available.

Residential Short Term stays

Some Nursing homes and Assisted Living facilities offer short-term respite stays, anywhere from a few days to a few weeks while the primary caregiver is unavailable, or to allow a rest from care-giving responsibilities. Facilities vary in the amount of hands on care they can provide, and what decision-making abilities they require of your loved one. Rates range from mid-\$200/day and up depending on the level of care needed. The following locations offer respite care based on bed availability, and it's important to know that all facilities will require specific documentation from a physician for a respite admission and advance notice.
