### Kenosha County Sheriff's Department Process Unit Deposit and Bond Schedule

#### Evictions

<b>OPTION #1 – WRITS OF RESTITUTION</b>	<b>Deposit</b>	<b>Bond of Indemnity</b>
Landlord takes responsibility for the property	\$250	No Bond Required
<b>OPTION #2 – WRITS OF RESTITUTION</b>	<b>Deposit</b>	<b>Bond of Indemnity</b>
Landlord wants KSD to take responsibility for property	\$1000	No Bond Required
<b>WRITS OF ASSISTANCE</b>	<b>Deposit</b>	<b>Bond of Indemnity</b>
Any location within the County	\$1000	No Bond Required

\*Bonds of Indemnity will be determined if needed by a Process Deputy. (Not always needed)

#### Writ of Replevins

<b>Property Item</b>	<b>Deposit</b>	<b>Bond of Indemnity</b>
Vehicle, Boat, RV, Etc. - (Per Vehicle)	\$250	*Actual Value Plus Any Fees
Other property	Varies-Deputies will determine after reviewing.	*Actual Value Plus Any Fees

\*Bonds of Indemnity will be determined if needed by a Process Deputy. (Not always needed)

#### Writ of Executions

<b>Judgment</b>	<b>Deposit</b>	<b>Bond of Indemnity</b>
Money demands and Till Taps only	\$250	*Actual Value Plus Any Fees
Money demand, personal property, and Real Estate. (Sheriff Sale Required)	Varies-Deputies will determine after reviewing.	*Actual Value Plus Any Fees
Real Estate or vehicles only (rare situation). Only if Plaintiff is seeking a residence or a vehicle and defendant does not have any money or other property to be seized in Kenosha County. (Sheriff Sale Required)	Varies-Deputies will determine after reviewing.	*Actual Value Plus Any Fees
Personal property that is ordered to be returned to plaintiff (No Sheriff Sale Required)	\$250 per item	*Actual Value Plus Any Fees

\*Bonds of Indemnity will be determined if needed by a Process Deputy. (Not always needed)

**Wisconsin Statute 815.24 Indemnity may be required.** If there is any reasonable doubt as to the ownership of the property or as to its liability to be taken on the execution the officer may require sufficient security to indemnify the officer for levying upon such property.
