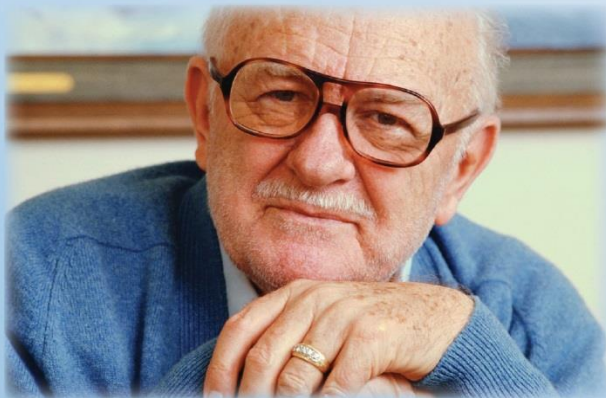

They guide your doctor and other health care professionals and relieve your family and friends from the burden of guessing what types of care and treatment you would want to receive.
